Recycling Program

Thumb Industries is proud to announce that it is expanding its recycling operations to include certain plastics and tin. The following is a detailed list of what is and is not accepted at our recycling center. **Please note that all containers must be clean and have all labels and caps removed prior to being accepted and recycled.**

Items Accepted

- **Corrugated cardboard** (any and all boxes, but nothing with food waste in it);
- **Boxboard** (i.e. cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, pop and beer cases, etc.);
- **Newspapers;**
- **Magazines and catalogs** (including phone books);
- **Junk mail** (including flyers, coupons and envelopes);
- **Mixed office paper** (all paper including, but not limited to colored, white, computer paper, sticky notes and all shredded paper);
- **Manila file folders;**
- **Tin cans** (all cans must be clean and have labels removed); and
- **Plastic containers** (all plastic that is labeled a #1 or #2 which includes water bottles, juice bottles, milk jugs, detergent containers, etc.
Containers must be washed out and have covers removed)



Items Not Accepted

- **Biodegradable or PLA plastics** (basically any other plastic container/material that is not labeled a #1 or #2);
- **Styrofoam;**
- **Packing material;**
- **Batteries;**
- **Light bulbs;**
- **Medical waste including syringes;**
- **Motor oil and/or filters;**
- **Automotive fluids;**
- **Hazardous waste;**
- **Paper cups, plates, napkins, etc.;**
- **Textiles;**
- **Glass;**
- **Household and construction materials;**
- **Electronics; and**
- **Trash.**
